Greetings MCC Members! It's hard to believe the calendar has already turned to August. There has been a lot going on at the Club since the last newsletter. Thanks to all who have been signing up for the numerous golf and social events. Carl and his team do a great job with the events to keep them fun and exciting and Devin's crew continues to keep the course in wonderful shape. I encourage everyone to sign up for an upcoming golf event or social dinner, as your schedules allow.

The Board would also like to welcome the new members that have joined since the last newsletter. Please see the list on the following page and make them feel welcome.

As was mentioned in the previous newsletter, the Board has been exploring a number of capital projects that are needed to keep making positive improvements at the Club. A couple larger scale projects in the works center around offsite and on-site course drainage as well as a revamping of the parking lot. Thankfully, the Club has been growing over the last handful of years which has allowed cash reserves to be set aside for these necessary projects.

A smaller project the Board would like to take on this Fall is to replace the existing wooden deck with a composite material and aluminum railing. The new deck will complement the deck furniture that was purchased this Spring and give the area a refreshed, modern look. It will also not require the ongoing maintenance the wooden deck regularly needs.

FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITY: LEAVE YOUR LEGACY!

To keep the positive momentum going at the Club, we'd like to extend an invitation to the membership to donate towards the cost of the new deck, so our cash reserves can remain ready for the larger projects. A plan is in place to install a decorative starter clock in between the tee boxes on Holes 1 & 10, similar to what is seen at other country clubs. The clock will have a paver base, and MCC members can purchase a brick paver to be individually engraved with your name or respectable words of your choice to commemorate your donation. The bricks will be sold for \$750/each and will be limited to the first 100 sold. This is an excellent opportunity to leave your legacy at MCC as this clock and paver base will become fixtures for the next generations to see as they head out on the course.

Thoughts from your Director of Grounds:

Hello Members! All things considered the golf course is holding up pretty well. Still a few spots recovering from the major rain events of July, certainly want to take the time to thank my crew for all of their help and hard work in getting the water of the golf course to keep our damage to a minimum. Due to the spike in membership (a great thing) we are seeing as much tee wear as ever, we will continue to rotate markers as much as possible to move the damage around and give heavy wear spaces a break. Please continue to sand the par 3 tees. See below for a few updates.

-Installed new drainage on #5 tee to fairway, behind #3 green, and behind #15 green.

-Verti cut greens for the third time this season, will continue to perform this practice monthly when the weather permits. Has made a big impact with dethatching and over all turf quality allowing the sand to really get into the canopy.

-Will continue to groom greens weekly as well as our Tuesday topdressing program when weather permits.

-September 9th will be our Fall Aeration date (weather permitting). Please mark your calendars as the Golf Course will be Closed all day to perform our most extensive greens work of the year. The plan will be to have everything done on the 9th with a fast recovery for the turf to get the greens back to the quality you expect.

-Please continue to do your part in helping us by repairing your ball marks and sanding divots. We certainly appreciate it!
